Power Gifts - Gifts of the Spirit in 1 Cor. 12:8-10

The Gifts of Revelation – word of wisdom, word of knowledge, discernment of spirits.

 The Gifts of Power - faith, healings, working of miracles.
 The Gifts of Utterance / Speech.

1. Gift of Faith

The gift of faith is an unshakable conviction given by God that He is going to act supernaturally in a particular situation.

2 Kings 4:42-44

42 A man came from Baal Shalishah, bringing the man of God twenty loaves of barley bread baked from the first ripe grain, along with some heads of new grain. "Give it to the people to eat," Elisha said.

2 Kings 4:42-44

43 "How can I set this before a hundred men?" his servant asked. But Elisha answered, "Give it to the people to eat. For this is what the Lord says: 'They will eat and have some left over."

44 Then he set it before them, and they ate and had some left over, according to the word of the Lord.

The working of miracles is when God uses us to effect a miracle by His divine power.


















Barriers in Activating / Growing in the Gifts of the Spirit.
