
- Jesus speaks of the Holy Spirit as a divine person with personal traits and attributes.

Who is the Holy Spirit?

Indrelling of the Holy Spirit vs Filling of the Holy Spirit

- The <u>indwelling of the Spirit</u> is a onetime event that takes place at the moment of salvation.
- The Filling of the Spirit takes place after a person is saved. There are many times, a person can be filled with the Holy Spirit. It is a repeatable event and a continuing process in the life of a believer.





- Imperative ... it is a command.
- Passive ... it is not something we do
- Plural ... it belongs to everybody.
 Every believer have an equal access to the filling of the Spirit.
- Present tense or active tense ... ongoingly... a constant action.
