
Of the 31,102 verses in the Bible, 2,350 deal with money and possessions

ETERNAL WEALTH

- More important
- How we deal with our material wealth will have a lot to do with how much eternal wealth we end up with

Tithing

Setting apart for God the first 10th of our income. 10 cents of every dollar is to go the Lord.

Began more than 400 years prior to the law of Moses

THE FIRST MENTION OF TITHING HAD TO DO IN RESPONSE TO GOD'S VICTORY WHEN ABRAHAM GAVE FIRST TIME, 10% TO MELCHIZEDEK

First practice of Tithing



ABRAHAM GAVE A TENTH BEFORE THE LAW CAME THROUGH

Genesis 14:18-20

18 And Melchizedek, the king of Salem and a priest of God Most High, brought Abram some bread and wine. 19 Melchizedek blessed Abram with this blessing:

"Blessed be Abram by God Most High,
Creator of heaven and earth.
20 And blessed be God Most High,
who has defeated your enemies for you."

Then Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of all the goods he had recovered.

Jesus affirms Tithing

Matthew 23:23

23 "What sorrow awaits you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. Hypocrites! For you are careful to tithe even the tiniest income from your herb gardens, but you ignore the more important aspects of the law—justice, mercy, and faith. You should tithe, yes, but do not neglect the more important things.

Whole nation under a curse



DON'T ROB GOD

GIVING OUTSIDE THE LOCAL CHURCH IS NOT A TITHE BUT AN OFFERING

STOREHOUSE

- God's prescribed method that all the tithes and offerings were to be brought to one place, the local church.
- The gospel is free but the propagation of the gospel is not.

God asks for a Tithe, not a Tip



GOD'S COMMAND: 10% TITHE

- 90% with you and God will go off a lot further than a 100% with you alone.
- It takes faith to believe that 90% blessed would go farther than a 100% not blessed.

Debt and Greed



- Struggle to bring tithe due to excessive debt.
- People spend every dollar they earn.
- People live beyond their means and accumulate debts

Debt and Greed



- High credit card debts cripple people financially.
- High unsettled debt is a reflection of mismanagement and irresponsibility with the Lord's resources

Debt and Greed



- Debt would create unnecessary tension in your life and in your marriage
- Having excessive debt is a bad testimony
- Financial freedom requires control of our spending habits

Contentment
