WHY BE THANKFUL?



Do you know how to say thank you from the heart?

- Why not make a choice to rejoice and be glad? Or do you get even and be bad

Let's start today with thankfulness to God, and cultivate an attitude of gratitude, a culture of being grateful from the heart.

Psalms 118:24 MEV - This is the day that the Lord has made

 "This is the day that the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it."



Enter His gates with thanksgiving
"Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth.
Worship the Lord with gladness;
come before him with joyful songs.
Know that the Lord is God.
It is he who made us, and we are his;
we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness

continues through all generations."

James 5:13 NLT - Pray and Praise

Are any of you suffering hardships? You should pray.

Are any of you happy? You should sing praises.

Follow the Example of Worshippers like King David and the Apostle Paul



1 Corinthians 11:1 NIV - Follow my Example

 Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:1 NLT - Imitate me and Christ

 And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ. Jesus does not want his followers to contradict the Holy Spirit, but to cooperate with the Holy Spirit.

Be Filled with the Spirit and bear fruit of the Spirit.



Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ.

He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God. Let there be no sexual immorality, impurity, or greed among you.

Such sins have no place among God's people.

Obscene stories, foolish talk, and coarse jokes-these are not for you.

Instead, let there be thankfulness to Gods





You can be sure that no immoral, impure, or greedy person will inherit the Kingdom of Christ and of God.

For a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world.

Don't be fooled by those who try to excuse these sins, for the anger of God will fall on all who disobey him.

Don't participate in the things these people do.

For once you were full of darkness, but now you have light from the Lord. So live as people of light!





For this light within you produces only what is good and right and true.

Carefully determine what pleases the Lord. Take no part in the worthless deeds of evil and darkness; instead, expose them.

It is shameful even to talk about the things that ungodly people do in secret.

But their evil intentions will be exposed when the light shines on them, for the light makes everything visible.

This is why it is said,

"Awake, O sleeper, rise up from the dead, and Christ will give you light." So be careful how you live.





Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise.

Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days.

Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.

Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life.

Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts.

And give thanks for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.





Gratitude is the antidote for many vices

- God is pretty much commanding us to be thankful in the good and bad and to use our lips and mouths to speak...
- Good not Evil
- Blessing not curses
- Positive words and not negative words
- Thankfulness not complaining



Words can defile you or define you

Matthew 15:18 NLT - Words from the heart or spirit

 "But the words you speak come from the heart - that's what defiles you."

Matthew 12:34 - The mouth speaks what is in the heart

 For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

Be thankful in all circumstances

Always be joyful.

Never stop praying.

Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.

Do not stifle the Holy Spirit.

Do not scoff at prophecies, but test everything that is said.

Leviticus 22:29-30 AMP - Offer a Thanksgiving Offering

"When you sacrifice an offering of thanksgiving to the Lord, you shall sacrifice it so that you may be accepted.

It shall be eaten on the same day; you shall leave none of it until the next morning; I am the Lord.

The thanksgiving offering is accompanied by music and singing

Psalms 95:2 NIV - Come before him with thanksgiving

 "Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song."

Psalms 69:30 - Glorify Him with thanksgiving

 "I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving."

Matthew 6:25-26 - No worries mate

"Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear.
