Forgiveness, what does it mean?

- Forgiveness is not forgetting.
- Forgiveness is a choice, a decision of the will.
- Forgiveness is agreeing to live with the consequences of another person's sin.
- Forgiveness is choosing not to hold someone's sin against him or her anymore.

How to forgive your brother/sister/enemy?

Matthew 18:23-35

- Not by quantity but by quality.
- Forgiveness is to be without limits.
- Forgiving from the heart.

A call to exercise forgiveness as a principle of life. Luke 6:27 Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

You have heard that it was said, "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth." But I tell you not to resist an evil person. But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also. If anyone wants to sue you and take your tunic away, let him have your cloak also. And whoever compels you to go one mile, go with him two. Give to him who asks you, and from him who wants to borrow from you do not turn away.
